






 **Men's Discussion Group—Tuesdays 7-8 am**



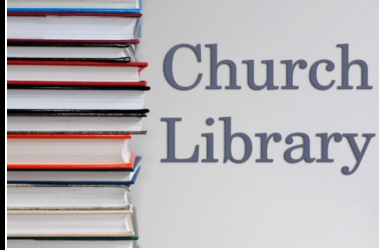
