

Today we celebrate two special occasions, Mother's Day and the founding of Eastridge Presbyterian Church. Since our beginning, EPC has been a congregation with a focus on Christ and our community. From the outset, the church and the new neighborhood where it was located have been integrally linked. Young families with children were the foundation of the Eastridge neighborhood and EPC became the church home for them. The "birth" of the church fittingly is celebrated on Mother's Day each year. The typical experience of being a mother in Eastridge is not always like the life of a Black mother.

Advocacy is one of the areas Eastridge has agreed to address as a Hunger Action Congregation. The Hunger Action Board would like to make you aware of LB108, currently under consideration before the Nebraska Legislature. It is called the SNAP Cliff Effect bill and will help families avoid needing to choose between accessing better job opportunities and keeping food on their tables when SNAP benefits might be decreased because the family has

received greater income through a raise or change of jobs.

The bill is now on Select File. If you'd like to share your support for the bill, please call your senator's office or go to the Legislature's webpage, find LB108, and click "submit comment."
