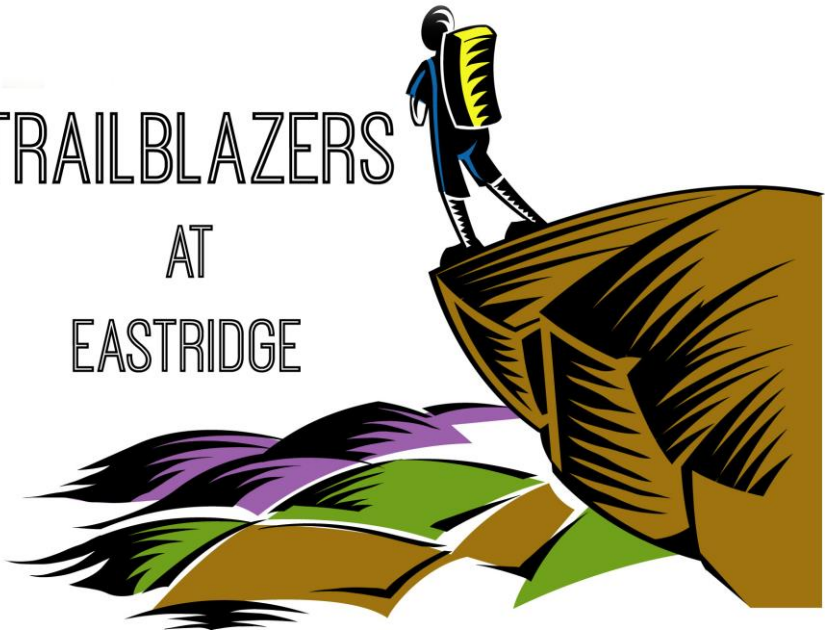

The Trailblazers Story

Trailblazers grew out of an established organization at Eastridge, the Surfsider Mariners. In 1992, the Surfsiders decided to disassociate from the National Mariners but to carry on as an active group. The Surfsider group was founded in 1961 and was itself an outgrowth of another Mariners group, the Commodore Mariners, established in 1954 as the first such group at Eastridge. Mariners is a Presbyterian organization whose primary emphasis is the support and nurture of marriage and family. As such our group provides an opportunity for men and women, singles as well as couples, to participate together in the life of the church in service and fellowship. Membership is open to all.

Beyond individual and family giving and our work for the church in regular activities, we take on the responsibilities as Trailblazers to aid the general mission of our congregation and participate in group activities.

Summer Flowerbed Maintenance Schedule

Trailblazers plant the flowerbeds in the courtyard. Members weed and clean this area. The responsibility is rotated on a week- to- week basis. The week starts on Sunday. The beds add beauty to the courtyard when everyone helps with the maintenance.

There will be a sign-up sheet for watering and weeding. If you are unable to be there for the planting date, a week for watering and weeding will be assigned. A copy of the schedule will be mailed to each family.
