

JUSTICE IN ACTION:

Current construction for "affordable housing" is being built to meet the needs of individuals and families with an income of \$60,000/year or more.

Due to current construction costs, the ability to build homes for families who make less than \$40,000/year is not obtainable.

The Affordable Housing research team is researching ways to make it possible for families who earn less than \$40K/year to live in affordable conditions. Plan to attend the **NEHEMIAH** ASSEMBLY where we will ask local officials to create better alternatives.
