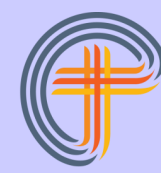

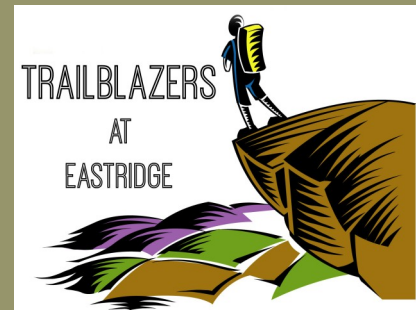

Following worship today, we will be taking down the Christmas decorations here at church. We'd love it if you stayed to assist!

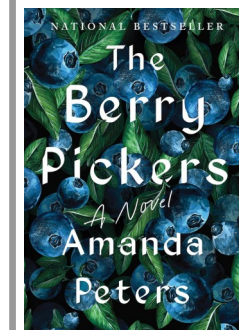
